The Ageing Population is a Global Dilemma & Malaysia is experiencing Population Ageing

Senior Care has become a leading concern and requirement for the ageing population in their own homes, as well as in Senior Care Homes and Institutions

UN studies indicate that the global population aged 65 and over is growing faster than all other age groups

- Globally, the population aged 65 years and over have increased from 6% in 1990 to 9.9% in 2022
- Currently, it has surged from 260 million in 1980 to 771 million globally
- By 2050, it is expected to grow to **17%** or **1.5 billion**
- Between 2020 and 2030 alone, the last baby boom cohorts reached age 65
- Recent estimates by the **Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM)** shows that the number has increased from 7.2% in 2022 to 7.4% in 2023 or 2.5 million Malaysians


